



People of Gaming Community Rules

This document serves as the official rules list for the online community People of Gaming, located at www.PeopleOfGaming.com. The rules listed here, apply to all mediums of the community including the forum, game and voice servers. Rules within a specific medium of the community apply only within their respective parts. Rules that are not explicitly defined here do not apply/exist. The interpretation of a rule is up to the most senior administrator in the community. Rules can be added or removed at any time, a website notification will be given when such changes occur. These rules do not apply to users, if they are not a member of the community. A member of the community is defined as a person who has a registered and verified account on the forum.

Section I (General Community Rules)

- A. Show/Give respect
 - a. Flaming/insulting of other players is prohibited, irrespective of whether or not it's mutual or both parties accept it as just play.
 - b. Racism or Bigot behavior is prohibited
- B. Spamming is not tolerated
- C. Provoking or Inspiring others to commit malicious activities is prohibited
- D. Posting warez (illegally obtained software/copyrighted material) is prohibited
- E. Posting a user's personal information without their consent is prohibited
- F. Moderators/Administrators cannot trade support or purchase/sell support for any material
- G. Selling in-game currency or items from People Of Gaming servers is prohibited

Section II (Forum Rules)

- A. As an English message board, English is required
- B. Any NSFW images/videos cannot be embedded and must have appropriate disclaimer
- C. Do not bump old threads (3 weeks or older)
- D. Post threads in their appropriate location
- E. Attempt to read a thread entirely before posting (as to not repeat anything or to raise a question already asked)

Section III (Community Ban Processes)

- A. A total of 5 infractions (since November 11, 2014) are permitted before a member is banned permanently from the community
- B. An infraction comes from any of People of Gaming's mediums.

- a. Any bans exceeding 1 day in length from People of Gaming's game servers
- b. Any bans exceeding 1 day in length from People of Gaming's voice servers
- c. Any bans/infractions from People Of Gaming's forum
- C. Infractions expire a year from the date the infraction is obtained/given
- D. Any member can be banned indefinitely if they are deemed a security threat
 - a. Threats include but are not limited to: Network attacks and Vulnerability Exploitation
- E. Permanent Bans are disputable at the time of their approval (within the week).
- F. Permanent Bans are indisputable for a minimum of 6 months, excluding the initial approval time.
